

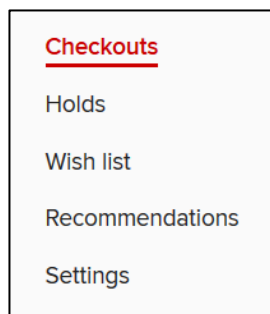
Using OverDrive for Devices without Apps Nook ereaders, other ereaders

BORROWING INFORMATION

Borrow ebooks, audiobooks, and more from the DeWitt Community Library - anywhere, anytime for your tablets, computers, smartphones, ereaders, MP3 players and more! All you need is a library card. You can borrow up to 10 digital titles (ebooks & audiobooks) at a time. Titles return automatically so there are no overdue fines. Set your borrowing time on your My Account > Settings page.



To **renew** an item: visit your online **Checkouts page** 3 days before your book is due to see if you can renew it.



You can do a lot from the **My Account** page. From the main page, you can find the My Account page in the upper right.

The account menu on the left of the screen on that page has many important features. From there, you can see all the items you have checked out, manage your holds, look at your wish list, find items you have recommended to the library and to change your settings.

AUTHORIZING

Authorizing Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) allows you to download DRM-protected eBooks. Newer versions of the ADE will **automatically authorize** when you sign in. Your ereader will use the same authorization that your computer uses.

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Click or tap the **Place a hold** button under a title (or on its details page). Enter and confirm your email address. Then, select **Place a hold**. When the title is available, it will be automatically checked out to you. You'll receive an email notification letting you know that it's waiting for you on your **Checkouts page**.

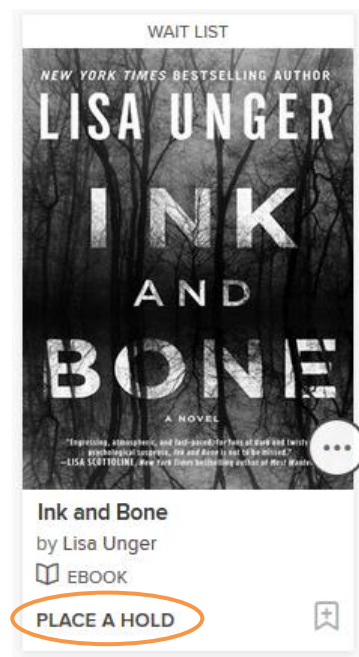

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SETUP

Step 1: CONNECT YOUR DEVICE AND DOWNLOAD ADOBE DIGITAL EDITIONS

Connect your ereader to your computer.

Install Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) on your computer.

BORROWING TITLES

Step 2: BROWSE OR SEARCH FOR A TITLE

Go to OCPL's OverDrive website: <https://onondaga.overdrive.com/> to start browsing. Browse or search for a title or author, or by your favorite genre.

Step 3: BORROW THE TITLE

Click **Borrow** under the format information. You will sign in to the OCPL OverDrive website with your library card number and PIN.

Step 4: ADD THE TITLE TO ADOBE DIGITAL EDITIONS

Once you've borrowed a title, go to the **My Account > Checkouts page** to see all of your options for the title.

From there, use the **Choose a format** button to select a downloadable format (for the best experience, we recommend **EPUB eBook** or though many eReaders also support **PDF eBook**).

If prompted, authorize ADE with a free Adobe ID or an OverDrive account (this is required for downloading DRM-protected eBooks).

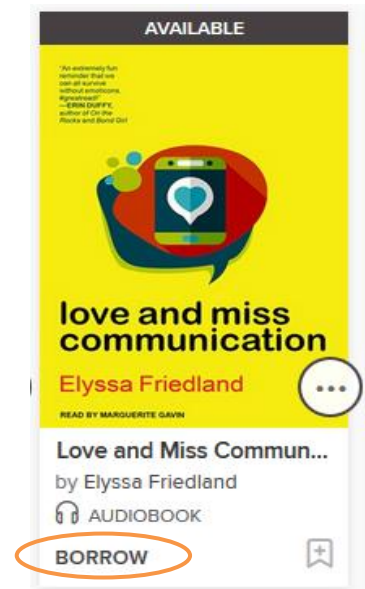
Downloaded eBooks open in Adobe Digital Editions on your computer.

Step 5: TRANSFER THE TITLE FROM ADOBE DIGITAL EDITIONS TO YOUR EREADER

These instructions are for ADE 2.0 or newer

1. Connect the eReader to your computer.
2. Open ADE on your computer. Make sure you are in "Library" view. Your eReader should show up under "Devices."
3. Click on an eBook, then drag it over to your device.

Once the transfer is complete, you can disconnect your device and start reading.
